Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Welcome to Reception! We are very excited about the year ahead and look forward to getting to know you all.

Thank you for taking the time to cover and label your child's book pack items. The books can be covered with any coloured or patterned contact or plastic covers. If you choose to use your own slip-on plastic covers then **please** ensure you secure them well with sticky tape as they can come off easily.

Please attach a large white stick-on label with your <u>child's name</u>, the <u>name of the subject</u> and <u>our class</u> <u>name</u> written clearly as shown in the example on the reverse.

Please read the list of book pack items on the reverse carefully and check that you have received all items listed. The list outlines the subject for each book so please ensure you label all items correctly. Other stationery items such as pencils, textas, rubbers, glue etc. will be provided in the classroom and do not need to be named.

<u>Please note</u>: the books **must** be returned to the school for the start of the school year, so your child has books to work with.

A homework bag will be provided by the school and will be given to your child on the first day of school. Inside this bag you will keep a Diary and Home Reading book, a homework exercise book, and later on, readers. You will need to check the Homework bag every night for notices as there will be plenty of them.

Please ensure your child has a clearly named library bag which can be purchased either from the uniform shop or elsewhere (children will not be able to borrow books from the library without a library bag).

Hats are needed for the first term as there is a 'no hat, no play' policy.
